


Figure S2. Bootstrapped difference tests between nodes in the network of GDS-15 symptom items among patients with Alzheimer’s dementia.




Figure S3. Bootstrapped difference tests between edge-weights in the network of GDS-15 symptom items among patients with mild cognitive impairment.




Figure S4. Bootstrapped difference tests between edge-weights in the network of GDS-15 symptom items among patients with Alzheimer’s dementia.




Figure S5. Bootstrapped confidence intervals of all edge-weights in the network of GDS-15 symptom items among patients with mild cognitive impairment.

Note: The red line indicates edge weights. The gray area indicates 95% confidence interval. Relatively narrow bootstrapped CIs indicate that estimates are precise.




Figure S6. Bootstrapped confidence intervals of all edge-weights in the network of GDS-15 symptom items among patients with Alzheimer’s dementia.
