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### Message from the Guest Editors

To achieve the goal of zero deforestation by 2030 and fully identify the carbon emission reduction potential of the land use sector, the Glasgow Leaders' Declaration on Forests and Land Use has been established. The implementation of sustainable Agriculture, Forestry, and Other Land Use (AFOLU) mitigation programs can significantly reduce GHG emissions and increase GHG removal potential for carbon neutrality targets. Despite their crucial role for climate stability, land use and land use change have received less attention from stakeholders compared to energy and transport systems.
