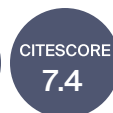

Recent advances in genetic screening, molecular profiling, targeted therapy, gene therapy and immunotherapy for soft tissue sarcomas (STS) have evoked increasing optimism in the medical and scientific community. Surgical resection is the standard of care for localized disease, but its recurrence rate is high and the prognosis for advanced STS is poor, with a median survival of 8–13 months.

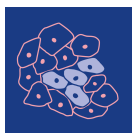
