



Figure S1. Survival rate of dechorionated zebrafish embryos at 144 hours post fertilization (hp) after exposure to doravirine (DOR) at gastrula stage (4 hp) by the immersion method. CO (-) represents embryos exposed to drug solvent only (fish water plus 0.1% dimethyl sulfoxide, DMSO). X-axis shows drug doses used for exposure of embryos; Y-axis shows the corresponding survival percentages. Results are expressed as mean \pm SD of three independent experiments, with 30 embryos for each experiment and each treatment. (** p < 0.005 vs. control group; *** p < 0.001 vs. control group)
