Changes in the periodontal inflamed surface area during the 24-month follow-up period




Figure S1. Changes in the periodontal inflamed surface area (PISA) during the 24-month follow-up period according to tooth-type

The PISA of the maxillary molar was increased, which may have affected the total PISA.
