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18 Transmission measurement of 0.02 g ml⁻¹ PPGA in 10 mM SPP buffer solution has shown a lower 19 critical solution temperature of 7.8 °C, while below 4 °C PPGA was completely soluble. The measured

- 20 concentration was in the same range as used for coupling to TMV.
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


Figure S1. SDS-PAGE of samples containing: (1) wt-TMV, (2) TMV-ketone, (3) TMV-ketone after

MiniTrap G-25 column and (6) control experiment including reaction of wt-TMV with PE-b-PEG.


