1. This Special Issue publishes both comprehensive reviews and original articles.

2. The submission deadline is **31 March 2020** and will be followed by a prompt review/revision process. The articles will be published upon acceptance on an ongoing basis. The review and publication processes will be handled by the Editorial Office.

3. *Biomolecules* (<http://www.mdpi.com/journal/cells>) is one of MDPI's open access journals. It is indexed in \*SCIE\*, PubMed and Scopus. It is eligible for inclusion in the Journal Citation Reports (JCR), and the Impact Factor (2018) is 4.694. *Biomolecules* has entered the ranking in the category 'Biochemistry & Molecular Biology' (SCIE) 58 of 298 (80.70%, Q1). The Article Processing Charges (APCs) are 1200 CHF (1800 CHF after **31 December 2019**) per accepted paper. **However, as a invited author, you can enjoy a 100% discount.** You may be entitled to a discount if you have previously received a discount code or if your institute is participating in the MDPI Institutional Open Access Program (IOAP); for more information, see: <http://www.mdpi.com/about/ioap>.
