2018 TRAVEL AWARD

FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

Candidates should fulfil the following:

- Postdoctoral fellows (within three years of receiving their Ph.D.) or Ph.D. students undertaking buildings-related research.
- They must present their own, original work as a poster or oral presentation at the conference for which the travel award application is being made.

Applicants are required to submit the following documents (The entire application package should be submitted as a PDF file):

- Outline of current and future work (1 page).
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- The conference to be attended, a copy of the abstract and acceptance letter or anticipated date of decision.
- Current grant funding and travel budget, if any, and why the applicant wishes to have the support of Buildings.
- A letter of recommendation from their supervisor, research director or department head (1 page).

There is no need to fill out an official form nor to have a prior submission or publication in *Buildings*. Any questions about the Travel Award can be directed to buildings@mdpi.com.
