

We are inviting applications for the Travel Awards for postdoctoral and Ph.D. researchers to attend an international conference of their choice in 2019. The awards will consist of two prizes of **600 CHF (Swiss Francs)**; one award of 600 CHF for postdoctoral researchers and one award of 600 CHF for PhD students.

The awardee will be determined by an evaluation committee, chaired by the Editor-in-Chief Prof. Dr. David Arditi, and also including Prof. Dr. George Baird, Prof. Dr. Cinzia Buratti, Prof. Dr. Umberto Berardi and Prof. Dr. Francisco López Almansa.

2019 TRAVEL AVARDS FOR POSTDOCTORAL AND Ph.D. RESEARCHERS

Candidates should fulfil the following criteria:

- Postdoctoral fellows (within three years of receiving their Ph.D.)
- Ph.D. students undertaking building-related research.
- They must present their own, original work as a poster or oral presentation at the conference for which the travel award application is being made.

Applicants are required to submit the following documents (the entire application package should be submitted as a single PDF file):

- Outline of current and future work (1 page).
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- The conference to be attended, a copy of the abstract and an acceptance letter or anticipated date of decision.
- Current grant funding and travel budget, if any, and why the applicant wishes to have the support of *Buildings*.
- A letter of recommendation from a supervisor, research director or department head (1 page).

There is no need to fill out an official form or to have a prior submission or publication in *Buildings*. Any questions regarding the Travel Awards can be directed to buildings@mdpi.com.
