## 2019 TRAVEL AWARDS

FOR POSTDOCTORAL AND Ph.D. RESEARCHERS

**Candidates should fulfil the following criteria:**

- Postdoctoral fellows (within three years of receiving their Ph.D.)
- Ph.D. students undertaking building-related research.
- They must present their own, original work as a poster or oral presentation at the conference for which the travel award application is being made.

**Applicants are required to submit the following documents (the entire application package should be submitted as a single PDF file):**

- Outline of current and future work (1 page).
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- The conference to be attended, a copy of the abstract and an acceptance letter or anticipated date of decision.
- Current grant funding and travel budget, if any, and why the applicant wishes to have the support of *Buildings*.
- A letter of recommendation from a supervisor, research director or department head (1 page).
