Dear Colleagues,

Maternal health is key to improving the health of children. Women have always been influential in their family's healthcare decisions. For example, over three-quarters of mothers are responsible for choosing their children's provider, taking their children to appointments, and consenting to receive recommended care (Kaiser, 2018). In contrast, only one-fifth of fathers have been reported to complete the same tasks (Kaiser, 2018). For instance, studies have found that maternal physical psychological health issues are associated with a high risk of physical and behavioral health issues in children (Logan et al., 2016; Rahman et al., 1993; Totskka et al., 2013). Improving the well-being of mothers is an essential factor in healthy children and families. This Special Issue calls for papers examining women's health and interventions that include mothers

The goal of this Special Issue is to discuss maternal health and any aspects of children's health influenced by the mother, who plays an essential role during the development of her children.
