This ranges from analyzing the effect of drugs on the respiratory tract (interstitial lung involvement secondary to oncologic therapy, immunosuppressive therapy, or cardiac therapy) to evaluating lung involvement in inflammatory bowel disease, neurological disease (brain-lung interaction), heart disease (the eternal dilemma: is it a cardiology or respiratory patient?), eye disease, infectious disease, endocrinological or skin disease.
