2017 ENERGIES YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AVARD

Eligibility Criteria:

- A one page personal statement detailing ground-breaking research and significant contribution to the advancement of the field;
- No more than 10 years since conferral of a PhD degree (by 31 January 2017);
- Two nomination letters from established scientists;
- A two page CV and an updated publication list.

Notes for the compilation of the application:

The candidates should be nominated by at least two established scientists. Self-nomination is not allowed. The nomination letter should highlight the young scientist's achievements and contribution to the field, preferably confirming his/her capacity to carry out independent research. A minimum font point size of 10 should be used for the preparation of required documents. More information can be found on *Energies* at: > www.mdpi.com/journal/energies.

The award will consist of: (1) **2,000 CHF (Swiss Francs)**; (2) an offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in Energies; and (3) an engraved plaque.
