2018 ENTROPY AWARDS YOUNG INVESTIGATOR PRIZE

Requirements:

1. The nominee has contributed outstanding research in the fields covered by the Entropy journal, see details at <http://www.mdpi.com/journal/entropy/about>.
2. The nominee should have received his/her PhD within the last eight years (by 31 December 2017), and not yet hold a permanent professorship.
3. The nominee should be 40 years of age or under (by 31 December 2017).

Required application documents:

1. CV (including date on which the PhD degree was awarded and a list of publications)
2. Research description (up to two pages)
3. Nomination letter from his/her supervisor, research director or department head

The prize consists of:

1. 2500 Swiss Francs;
2. the book *Probability Theory: The Logic of Science* by Edwin T. Jaynes;
3. a commemorative plaque;
4. a waiver of registration fees and a talk for the conference “Entropy 2018: From Physics to Information Sciences and Geometry” (<https://sciforum.net/conference/Entropy2018-1>).

The award ceremony will be hosted at Entropy 2018 conference, May 2018, Barcelona, Spain.
