Two Travel Awards for postdocs or PhD students consisting of CHF 800 / USD 850 / EUR 700 each will be awarded to attend forestry related conferences.

Eligibility:

The candidate must be enrolled as a full-time PhD student or a post-doctoral researcher (10 years or less since completing their PhD).

The candidate must be registered to attend and present an oral talk or poster at an international forestry conference/congress (e.g., IUFRO, Soil Science Society of America, Society of American Foresters...)

2019 TRAVEL AVARDS FOR POSTDOCS OR PHD STUDENTS

Candidates' Requirements:

a. Submit a resume/CV

b. The nominee should include a brief summary (one page) of their research interests, accomplishments, and expected benefits from attending the conference/ congress

- c. A letter of support from their supervisor and should include:
- Confirmation that the nominee is a PhD or post-doctoral student, describe the overall strengths of the candidate and eligibility for the travel award; and confirm that they will present an oral talk/poster at the conference. Relevance and expected benefits of the nominee's attendance at the conference.
