Message from the Guest Editors

Perioperative care practices worldwide are in the midst of a sea change with the implementation of multidisciplinary processes that improve surgical outcomes through (1) better patient education, engagement, and participation, (2) enhanced pre-operative, intra-operative, and postoperative care bundles, and (3) interactive audit programs that provide feedback to the surgical team. These improved outcomes include reduction in the frequency and severity of complications and improved throughput that ultimately reduce operative stress.
