## Required Application Documents:

1. Curriculum vitae and publication list.
2. A list of the candidate's top 10 publications in scholarly journals in the past 5 years. The candidate should be serving as the first or corresponding author.
3. Nomination letter from two established scientists. The letter should highlight candidates' achievements and contributions to the molecular sciences research field and recommend them for this award; self-nomination is not accepted.

The award which consists of **2000 CHF and a certificate** will be granted to investigators in each of the following fields: **Molecular Biology** and **Molecular Pathology**.
