Required Application Documents:

- 1. Curriculum vitae and publication list.
- 2. A list of the candidate's top 10 publications in scholarly journals in the past 5 years. The candidate should be serving as the first or corresponding author.
- 3. Nomination letter from two established scientists. The letter should highlight candidates' achievements and contributions to the molecular sciences research field and recommend them for this award; self-nomination is not accepted.

The award which consists of **2000 CHF and a certificate** will be granted to investigators in each of the following fields: **Molecular Biology** and **Molecular Pathology**.
