MMPs (matrix metalloproteinases), ADAMs (a disintegrin and metalloproteinase domain), ADAMTSs (a disintegrin and metalloproteinase thrombospondin domain), astacins (including meprins). and neprilvsins are metalloendopeptidases. Metalloproteinases play fundamental roles in extracellular matrix remodeling, and cytokine/growth factor release and processing.
