Squamous cell carcinoma is the most common cancer among head and neck cancers. In salivary glands, there are many types of malignancies that can develop, such as malignant lymphoma, adenoid cystic carcinoma, adenocarcinoma, and mesenchymal tumors. In a clinical setting, imaging, such as Computed Tomography (CT) and Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI), is very important in terms of the prediction of histological type and evaluation of the extent of invasion of adjacent structures.
