2018 TRAVEL AWARDS

FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

Candidates' Requirements:

- 1. The applicant must be a PhD graduate student or a postdoctoral fellow.
- 2. The candidate should provide an active registration at a university or a letter from the supervisor on his/her scholar status.
- 3. The applicant must present his/her own original work as an oral or poster presentation at the conference for which s/he has been awarded.

Applicants should provide:

- 1. An abstract that will be submitted to the conference being held in 2018 (conference format is acceptable).
- 2. An updated Curriculum Vitae.
- 3. Justification letter for the choice of the conference and costs.
- 4. Letter of support from her/his mentor/institution for the remaining cost if applicable.

The Awards will consist of **800 Swiss Francs** each, and may be used for registration, travel, or accommodation. The awardee must provide a copy of the page in the conference program showing the abstract/presentation and meeting badge after attending the conference.
