Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce **two Materials Travel Awards** that will allow junior scientists to attend an international conference of their choice in 2019. The applications will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee chaired by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Maryam Tabrizian.

Candidate Requirements:

- The applicant must be a PhD student or a postdoctoral fellow.
- The candidate should provide an active registration certificate at a university or a letter from the supervisor on his/her scholar status.
- The applicant must present his/her own original work as an oral or poster presentation at the conference for which he/she has been awarded.

Required Application Documents:

- An abstract that will be submitted to the conference being held in 2019 (conference format is acceptable).
- An updated Curriculum Vitae.
- A justification letter for the choice of the conference and costs.
- A letter of support from their mentor/institution for the remaining cost if applicable.

2019 MATERIALS TRAVEL AWARDS FOR POSTDOCS AND PhD STUDENTS

The Awards will consist of **800 Swiss Francs for each awardee**, and may be used for registration, travel, or accommodation. The awardee must provide a copy of the page in the conference program showing the abstract/presentation and meeting badge after attending the conference.

Application materials of candidates should be submitted via the link (<http://www.mdpi.com/journal/materials/awards>). We welcome nominations and applications for this award by **31 December 2018**. The winners will be announced by the end of **February 2019**.
