Candidate Requirements:

Required Application Documents

1. Detailed curriculum vitae including a list of research grants and publications.
2. Signed nomination letter from two established scientists in the field.
3. A scanned copy of the applicant's doctorate certificate.

The Award Will Consist of:

- 2000 Swiss Francs and a certificate.
- An offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in *Materials*.
