Message from the Guest Editor

Head and neck cancers are the sixth most frequent cancer in the world, with a very poor prognosis in progressed stages and the majority of patients appear in stages that are already associated with metastasis.

The survival rates remain unaltered, although new strategies of surgery and reconstruction, intensity modulated strategies and chemotherapeutic protocols have been implemented. Very recently, the survival rates are improving due to study-based introduction of immune modulatory approaches. The field is driven by the search of tumor biological behaviors translationally reaching to clinical application.

This Special Issue aims to collect submissions related to the epidemiology, genetic factors, immunologic interactions and treatment and outcomes of head and neck cancers.
