Eligibility and Requirements:

1. Received a Ph.D. degree within the past 10 years.
2. Ground-breaking research conducted and a significant contribution made to the advancement of the sensors research field.

List of Documents for Application:

1. Detailed Curriculum Vitae including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants.
2. Birth certificate or other proof of age.
3. Scanned copy of doctorate certificate.
4. Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

The award will consist of:

1. 2000 Swiss Francs,
2. an offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in *Sensors* after peer review, and
3. an engraved plaque.

We welcome nominations and applications for this award until **31 December 2017**.
