## 2018 SUSTAINABILITY AWARD YOUNG INVESTIGATOR

### Eligibility and Requirements:

1. Hold an earned Ph.D. degree.
2. Be 35 years age or under (as of 31 December 2018)
3. Have conducted ground-breaking sustainability research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the field of sustainability.
4. Priority will be given to applicants who publish papers in *Sustainability* in 2018.

### List of Documents for Application:

1. Detailed Curriculum Vitae including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's research grants.
2. Detailed 2018 publication list including authors, title and journal.
3. List of conferences the candidate attended in 2018 and the research results presented.
4. Scanned copy of doctorate certificate.
5. Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

### The award will consist of:

1. 2000 Swiss Francs
2. An engraved plaque

We welcome nominations and applications for this award until 31 December 2018.
