Candidates' Requirements:

- 1. The nominee has contributed outstanding research in the fields covered by the Symmetry journal, see details at http://www.mdpi.com/journal/symmetry/about
- 2. The nominee should have received his/her PhD within the last eight years (by 30 November 2018), and not yet hold a permanent professorship
- 3. The nominee should be 40 years of age or under (by 30 November 2018)

Required application documents:

- 1. CV (including date on which the PhD degree was awarded and a list of publications)
- 2. Research description (up to two pages)
- 3. Nomination letter from his/her supervisor, research director or department head

The prize consists of:

- 1. 2000 Swiss Frances;
- 2. An offer of a free paper published in Symmetry Feature Paper Special Issue series
- 3. a certificate
