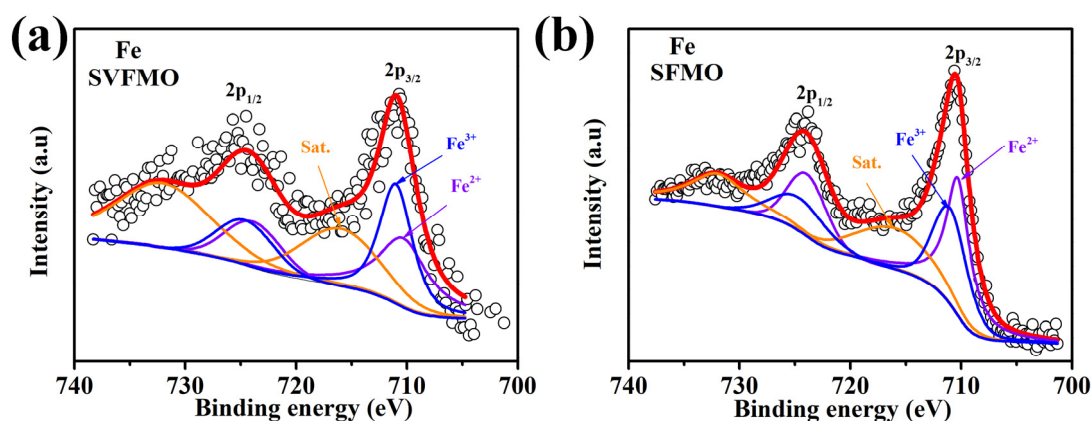


Figure S1. XPS of Fe 2p for SVFMO and SFMO anode.

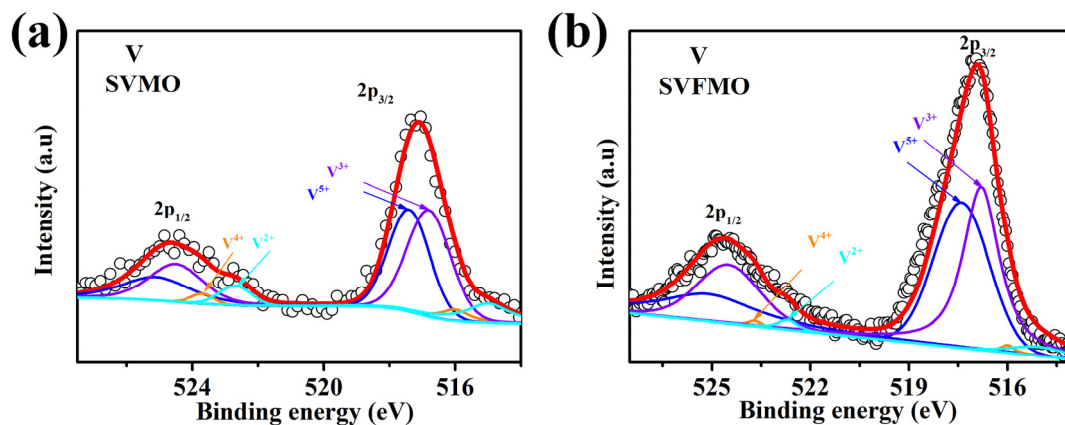


Figure S2. XPS of V 2p for SVMO and SVFMO anode.

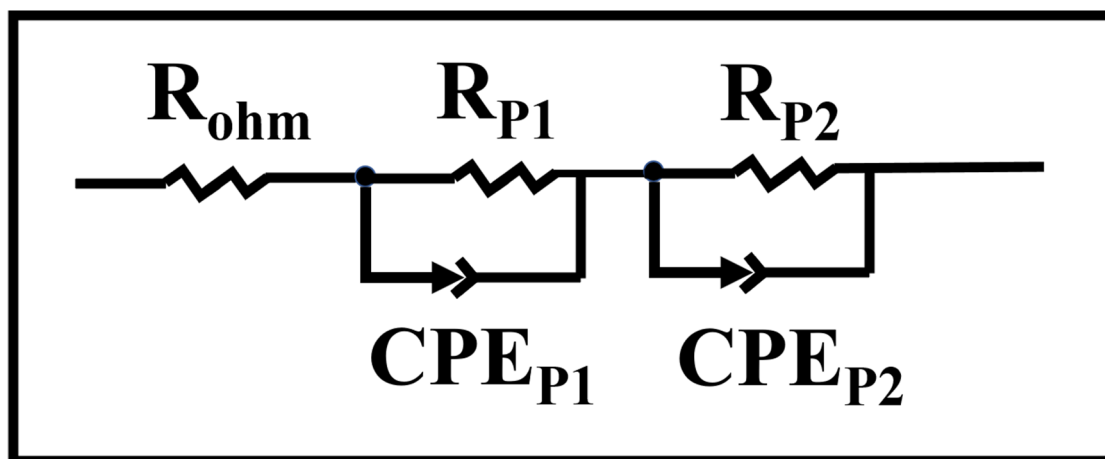


Figure S3. The equivalent circuit for the fitting EIS of symmetric cells (testing at 850).
