Methodology: Food Liking ( $\mathrm{n}=50$ ). The majority of the children ( $64 \%$ ) rated the cheese sandwich as 'yummy' (Table S1). Children predominantly rated carrot and cucumber as 'yummy' ( $58 \%$ and $50 \%$ respectively) and red pepper and cherry tomatoes as 'yucky' ( $58 \%$ and $48 \%$ respectively).
