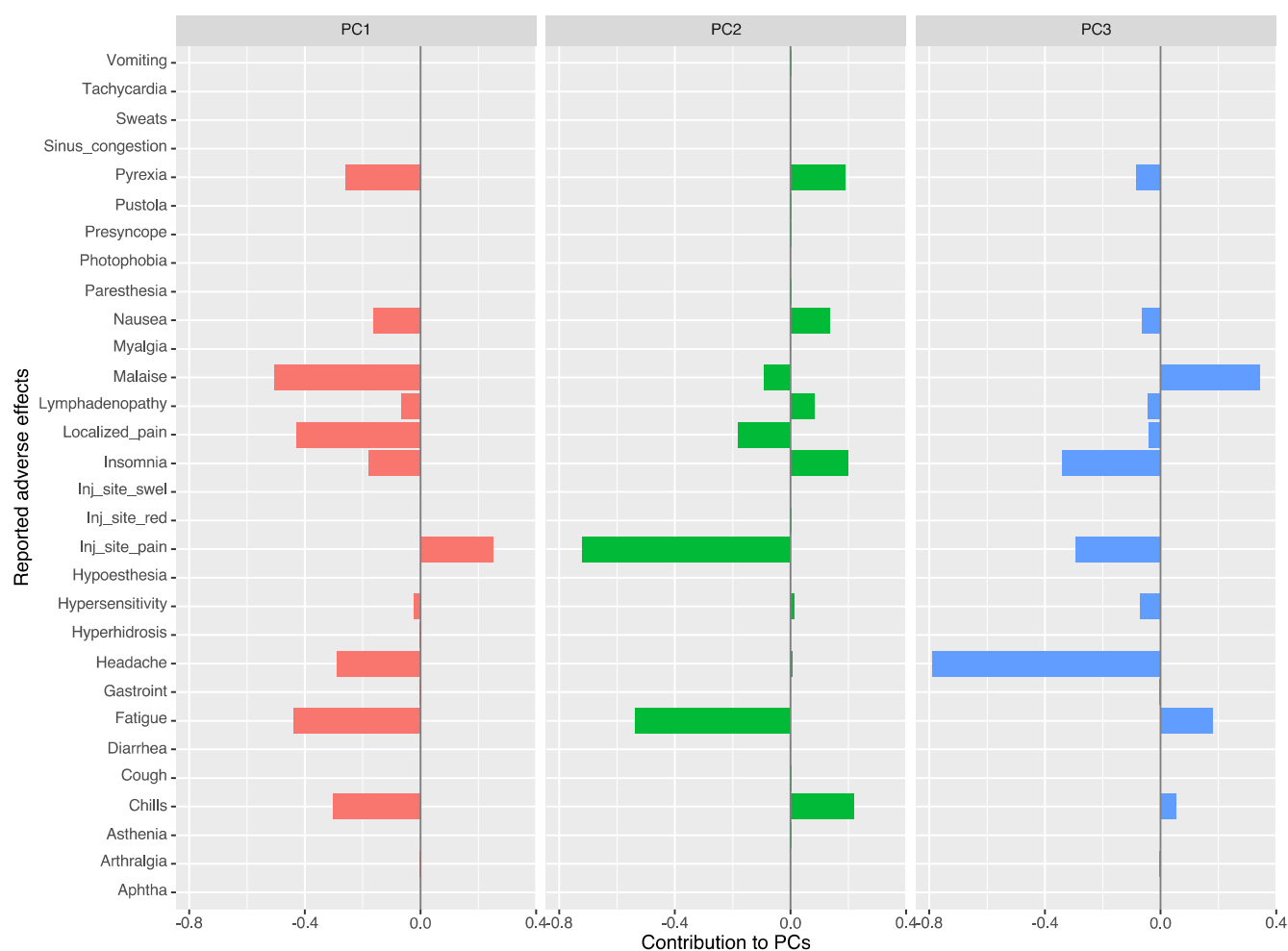
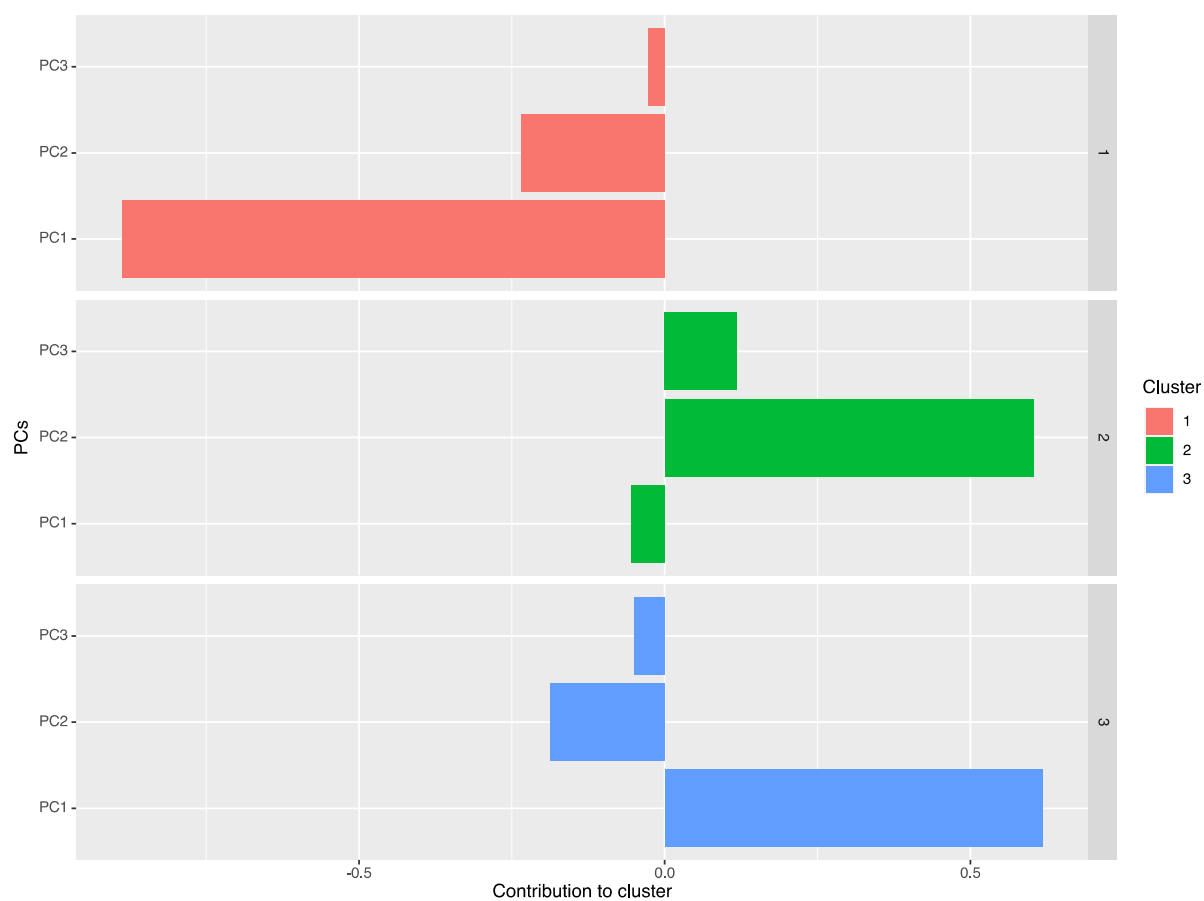


**Figure S1.** Spearman's correlation matrix of reported adverse reactions. Correlation coefficients ( $r_s$ ) are included in cells and graphically summarized as a heatmap, with colours ranging from blue for negative values to red for positive values. There are two cases of  $r_s=1$  (injection site swelling ~ aphtha, vomiting ~ pustola) since these pairs of adverse effects were reported only once together.
