Candidate Requirements:

- Applicants must be PhD students, postdoctoral fellows or young lecturers working in the field of organization studies, or another academic field as long as their expertise satisfies the journal's aim and scope. - Applicants plan to participate in an international conference in 2019 to present their research (oral or poster presentation).

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- The applicant's oral or poster abstract for the conference, indicating the conference name and website.
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- A brief letter (500 words) describing the focus of the research and the nature of the conference.
- A letter of recommendation (max. 400 words).

The award consists of 800 CHF (or 810 USD/720 EUR). Each winner is welcome to publish one paper in Administrative Sciences free of charge.
