2018 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR



Eligibility and Requirements:

- Received a Ph.D. degree within the past 10 years involved in the fields of environmental and sustainable science and technology;
- Is 35 years of age or under (as of 31 October 2018);
- Has conducted ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the field of "enviornmental and sustainable science and technology".
- Priority will be given to applicants who publish papers in Applied Sciences in 2018.

List of Documents for Application:

- A detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants.
- A scanned copy of one's doctorate certificate.
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

The award will consist of the following:

- 1500 Swiss Francs for the winner.
- An offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in *Applied Sciences* after peer review.
- An engraved plaque.

We welcome nominations and applications for this award until 30 November 2018.

Nomination and application materials of eligible candidates should be submitted with the subject via the link (http://www.mdpi.com/journal/applsci/awards). The winner will be announced in the middle of **January 2019**.
