We are pleased to announce that *Children* is now inviting nominations for the *Children* 2021 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their research achievements related to children's health. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Professor Sari A. Acra.

The Prize

- 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- The option to publish one peer-reviewed paper free of charge in *Children* before the end of December 2022.

Eligibility and Requirements

- Candidates must have conducted groundbreaking research and/or made a significant contribution to the advancement of children's health;
- Must be below 35 years of age and have received their PhD or MD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2020;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists or their supervisors/mentors.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- A description of the candidate's research and a scanned copy of the doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two senior scientists/supervisors/mentors.

Schedule

- Nomination deadline: 17 December, 2021;
- Winner announcement: 28 February 2022.
