Dear Colleagues, we are proud to announce our special issue for Pediatric Orthopedic and Trauma Surgery.

Pediatric injuries, respectively of the growing skeleton have the risk to severely impact lifestyle and mobility despite an extremely favourable healing potential. Further, trauma still represents the number one cause of death among children. Due to their altered physiology and anatomy, children are not to be treated like adults.
