## 2019 COATINGS YOUNG INVESTIGATOR ANAR D

## **Eligibility Criteria:**

- A one-page personal statement detailing ground-breaking research and a significant contribution to the advancement of the field;
- No more than 5 years since conferral of a PhD degree (by April 2019);
- Signed nomination letter from an established senior scientist;
- A two-page CV and an updated publication list.

## Notes for the compilation of the application:

The candidates should be nominated by an established senior scientist. Self-nomination is not allowed. The nomination letter should highlight the young scientist's achievements and contribution to the field, preferably confirming his/her capacity to carry out independent research. A minimum font point size of 10 should be used for the preparation of required documents. More information can be found on *Coatings* at http://www.mdpi.com/journal/coatings.

The award will consist of (1) **2000 CHF (Swiss Francs)**, (2) an offer to publish a paper free of charge without a fixed deadline in *Coatings*, and (3) an engraved plaque.
