Vascular diseases represent the most frequent cause of death in developed countries. Human vessels, especially veins, also represent a path for tumor spreading. Arterial diseases affect all 3 wall layers—intima, media, and adventitia. Subclinical arterial inflammation, but also wall shear stress and elasticity changes, represent important mechanisms that lead to atherosclerosis.

Modern medicine enables both invasive and non-invasive visualization of these processes. Many methods are already used clinically—from angiography, duplex Doppler examination, CT or MR angiography to optical coherence microscopy, etc.

The planned issue of *Diagnostics* will bring together original studies and review articles describing the use of these methods, and it is open for your submissions.
