- The quality of the reviews will be taken into consideration, including the quality of the review reports and the completing time.

What will the winners receive?

This award will consist of three awardees, and each will receive the following:

- A certificate
- **500 Swiss Francs** (CHF)
- An offer to publish a paper free of charge, without a fixed deadline in *Electronics*, after peer review in 2019.

When will the winners be announced?

- The winners will be announced on the journal website, early in 2019.
