A growing diffusion of RES-based Distributed Generation is expected in the next years due to the progressive reduction of its investment cost making these systems more profitable and competitive by reaching the grid parity. This evolution has changed the classical approach of grid development converting the energy flows within the electrical networks to promote energy self-consumption and energy independence.
