The applications will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee consisting of senior scholars from the *Forests* Editorial Board.

This award provides financial support to the winners so that they can attend an international conference in the field of forest science to be held in 2023, in order to hold a presentation, present a poster, or both.

## **2023 TRAVEL AVAARD** FOR POSTDOCS AND PHD STUDENTS

## **Candidate Requirements:**

- Postdoctoral fellows or PhD students;
- Plans to attend an international conference in 2023 (oral or poster presentation).

## **Required Application Documents:**

- Information of the conference the applicant is planning to attend and the abstract that will be submitted;
- Curriculum vitae and a list of publications;
- Justification letter describing the focus of the research (max. 800 words);
- Letter of recommendation from the applicant's supervisor, research director, or department head, which also confirms the applicant's status as a postdoctoral fellow/PhD student.

## The Winners will be Awarded the Following:

- CHF 600 for a virtual conference or CHF 800 for a physical conference;
- An offer to publish one paper with a 50% discount on the APC in *Forests* by the end of 2023;
- A certificate.

Please submit your applications for the *Forests* 2023 Travel Award online before 31 December 2022. The prize will be awarded on 28 February 2023 and announced on the *Forests* website.
