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Message from the Guest Editor

This Special Issue of *Forests* guides forestland managers and academicians through current research findings to assess forest product markets, their impacts on local, national, and global markets, and the influences on sustainability. Each manuscript will define markets and their geographic extent for (a) natural resource sources, (b) processing expertise, and (c) final product markets. Forest products include physical products produced through wood harvest, processing, and market delivery, as well as natural processes and societal sustainability delivered by the management of forestlands. Manuscripts will include research in:

1. Wood product markets;
2. Economics to articulate and measure achievements of desired ownership goals;
3. New or previously underutilized forest product amenities with potential for expansion;
4. Societal achievement through forestland management utilization.





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
