Candidates' Requirements:

 The applicants must be PhD graduate students or postdoctoral fellows involved in gel-based materials research.

Required Application Documents:

- An abstract of their work (including a statement on its impact and significance).
- A Curriculum Vitae, including a complete list of publications.
- The conference they plan to attend and the work that they will present.
- A letter of recommendation from a supervisor.
- A copy of the page of the conference program showing the awardee's abstract or presentation and the meeting badge that verifies his/her attendance, to be provided after the meeting.

The journal *Gels* (ISSN 2310-2861) is an international, open access journal on physical (supramolecular) and chemical gel-based materials. Our aim is to encourage scientists to publish their experimental and theoretical results in as much detail as possible. Therefore, there is no restriction on the length of the papers, and full experimental details must be provided so that the results can be reproduced. Short communications, full research papers, and review papers are accepted.
