Dear Colleagues,

The journal *Geosciences* (MDPI, Switzerland, ISSN 2076-3263, <https://www.mdpi.com/journal/geosciences>) is inviting applications for the *Geosciences* 2021 Best Ph.D. Thesis Award. This prize will be awarded to a Ph.D. student who is about to graduate or participate in the graduation thesis. The applications will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee consisting of senior scholars from the *Geosciences* Editorial Board.

Eligibility Requirements:

- a. The candidate must be a Ph.D. student who is going to graduate or participate in graduation thesis defenses.
- b. The Ph.D. thesis must be original work.
- c. The Ph.D. thesis must be defended between 1 September 2021 and 31 August 2022.
- d. Applicants are required to submit the following documents:
 - An executive summary of the Ph.D. thesis, in English, of around 3000 words;
 - A letter from the Ph.D. supervisor recommending the candidate for consideration for this award;
 - The candidate's CV, including a list of publications connected with the thesis;
 - An electronic copy of the Ph.D. thesis;
 - A scanned copy of the Ph.D. diploma (or certificate of study at a school or research institute as a Ph.D. student going to graduate or participate in graduation thesis defenses).

Selection Criteria:

- Quality of resume and publications;
- Relevance of the candidate and research description;
- Novelty of the candidate's Ph.D. thesis;
- Strength of the recommendation letter;
- Anticipated academic potential;
- Originality and impact of the research.

Prizes:

- Bonus (CHF 800);
- Certificate;
- Offer to publish a featured paper in *Geosciences* with the article processing charge (APC) waived before 30 June 2023.

The application deadline is 1 September 2022. The winner will be announced on the *Geosciences* website by October 2022.
