Stroke is a leading contributor to the burden of disease worldwide. Annually, stroke affects approximately 15 million people worldwide and is a major cause of disability. Although acute treatment interventions can reduce the impact of stroke, many are underutilised in practice and this represents an opportunity to intervene and prevent disability or deaths. Prevention interventions are also inconsistently applied and may be enhanced by use of ehealth solutions. By making innovative changes to the health system to enable greater access to evidence-based care, the impact of stroke could be moderated.

This Special Issue seeks empirical and review papers related to any of these themes, and is not intended to be exclusive of other topics that may be relevant to improving stroke care in hospitals or the community. Developmental (early phase) or pilot projects for innovative programs to support recovery will also be considered.
