Applicants Requirements:

- Applicants must be PhD students or postdoctoral fellows working in the field of literature studies, or related academic field within the journal's aim and scope, see (http://www.mdpi.com/journal/humanities/about).
- Applicants plan to participate in an international conference in 2019 to present their research (oral or poster presentation).

Applicants are required to submit the following documents:

- The applicant's oral and official acceptance letter from the conference, or poster abstract for the conference, indicating the conference name and website.
- CV, including a complete list of publications.
- A brief letter (500 words) describing the focus of the research and the nature of the conference.
- A letter of recommendation (max. 400 words).

We welcome nominations and applications for this award up until 30 November 2018.
