J., U.S. Patent 4289872, Sept 15, 1981), and in 1982 the first article was published on the properties of these dendrimers (S.M. Aharoni, **C.**R. Crosby, E.K. Walsh, Macromolecules 1982, 15, 1093).

Our Special Issue commemorates the 40th anniversary of this first article on lysine dendrimers.

We would like to include papers of those who have made a significant contribution to the development of synthesis methods, computer simulations, and investigations into the properties and applications of lysine and peptide dendrimers.
