It is becoming increasingly apparent that complex histological and biomolecular mechanisms play a role in the genesis and recurrence of intracranial meningiomas.

Whenever a high extent of resection is achieved in low grade meningiomas, it is clear that recurrence rates are reduced. The problem is more complex with intermediate-to-high grade lesions, where recurrence is the result of a complex process involving tumor biology and location, surgical extent of resection and the patient characteristics. The implementation of next-generation diagnostic tools, such as the analysis of the methylome, is certainly promising but has not yet achieved worldwide application.

Here, we invite you to submit original and review articles on the topic, focusing on the biomolecular aspects of meningiomas when it comes to their diagnosis, treatment and prognosis.
