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### Message from the Guest Editors

Implementation of high-sensitivity cardiac troponin assays revolutionized diagnostic algorithms, in particular for patients with non-ST-elevation acute coronary syndromes (ACS). However, diagnosis may be challenging, especially in patients with inconclusive electrocardiograms and those without detectable stenosis in invasive coronary angiography.

This Special Issue focuses on innovative diagnostic and therapeutic strategies as well as comprehensive prognostic evaluation of patients with ACS. Among others, this comprises the management of patients with myocardial infarction with non-obstructive coronary arteries (MINOCA). What is the use of optical coherence tomography (OCT) in these patients? What is the value of cardiac magnetic resonance (CMR) imaging for diagnosis and prognostic assessment? Are there any upcoming invasive and non-invasive therapeutic strategies in patients with high-risk ACS?

We welcome the submission of “state-of-the-art” review articles as well as “cutting-edge” original research papers dealing with the topics of diagnostic and therapeutic advances in patients with ACS.





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
