Message from the Guest Editor

Urticaria is a disorder that still causes many problems in general, allergological, and dermatological practice. Its pathophysiology includes genetic, hormonal, and inflammatory abnormalities. The symptoms of urticaria are undoubtedly the cause of distress for patients, having a detrimental influence on patients' quality of life and resulting in emotional disturbances. Previous analyses proved significant psychological and psychiatric comorbidity in the course of urticaria. Accompanying pruritus often disturbs the sleep cycle. Recurrent angioedema, often coexisting with wheals, is an important problem in daily practice and emergency medicine and one of the most important symptoms of urticaria. In this Special Issue, we will focus on innovations and advancements in urticaria pathogenesis and management, and we hope to provide more information that will be useful for daily practice and future research.
