- Postdoctoral fellows or PhD students working on models for a dataset available on <https://data.mendeley.com/datasets/h3yhs5gy3w/1>, which is used in Myszkowski, N., & Sorme, M. (2018). A snapshot of g ? Binary and polytomous item-response theory investigations of the last series of the Standard Progressive Matrices (SPM-LS). *Intelligence*, 68, 109–116.
- Submission of a manuscript with the results to the *Journal of Intelligence* for a special issue on the dataset.
- Acceptance of a paper or poster presentation at the International Meeting of the Psychometric Society (IMPS) 2019 in Santiago (Chile). The deadline for submission to IMPS is February 15, see <https://psychometricsociety.org/content/imps-2019-announcement>.

Applicants Are Required to Submit the Following Documents:

- Curriculum vitae, including educational and professional experience and a complete list of publications.
- The accepted abstract for the presentation at the IMPS conference.
- A first draft of the manuscript to be submitted to the *Journal of Intelligence*.
- A letter of recommendation from the supervisor/research director or department head.

The awards will consist of **1000 CHF** and a certificate.

Please submit your nominations and applications for the award on the website before **31 March 2019**. The winner will be informed via email and the award will be highlighted on the homepage of *Journal of Intelligence* in **April 2019**.
