The emerging field of cardio-oncology described several shared risk factors that predispose patients to both cardiovascular disease and cancer. Preventive and therapeutic cardiology and cardio-oncology are increasingly evolving, involving multiple metabolic and immunological risk factors. New cardioprotective drugs include SGLT2i, PCSK9i, selective inhibitors of cytokines, chemokines and NLRP-3, improving glucose and lipid homeostasis and chronic low-grade inflammation.
